I've also contributed to the ECEAP expansion think tank, and I currently hold a leadership role on the composition design team.

Our state is moving toward **90% Preschool Entitlement by 2026**, which means significantly more preschool slots in schools, along with more busing of children aged 2 through 4. I'm here to offer you the chance to **keep your families with you** and provide the best care close to home.

Two additional benefits of partnering with us:

- **1.** We provide **individual Family Support Specialists** for your program and families. These specialists aren't social workers or case managers; they act as resource specialist to help your program and families succeed. Our Regional Director serve as your individual onboarding specialist/point person.
- **2.** We also host **monthly family engagement nights** that are completely free for you and your families.

For each eligible child who remains in your program, you'll receive additional monthly funding. **YES provides the infrastructure**, while you maintain your relationships with families and students.
